<p>Proposal of 3 Ideas</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Using your sketchbook, you will present three unique ideas for your Genius Hour project. • For each idea, you will need to include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ A written description of what you want to make and why (1-2 sentences is fine) ○ Rough sketches in the form of thumbnails (1-2 images for each is fine) ○ Materials you will need to make the project • You will need to tear out the page(s) you used to complete this assignment and submit it to your class bin on the due date. 	<p>Friday, August 19th</p>
<p>Final Proposal</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Select one final idea from your proposal of 3 ideas. • In your sketchbook, include the following for the final idea (all can be done on the same page): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ A paragraph about what you want to make and why ○ 1-3 goals for what you wish to accomplish through your Genius Hour project ○ 1-2 small rough sketches of your final idea, showing more detail than in the proposal of 3 ideas ○ The steps you will need to take to complete your project ○ The materials and supplies you will need to make your project • Tear out the page(s) and submit for grading on the due date 	<p>Friday, August 26th</p>
<p>Rough Sketches of Final Idea</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In your sketchbook, use a full page to draw out your final idea. • Tear out of your sketchbook and submit on the due date. 	<p>Friday, September 2nd</p>
<p>Materials & Supplies Check</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Using the list you created in your Final Proposal, collect from me and/or bring in the supplies you need to begin working on your actual Genius Hour project. • This will be the first official work day of the project. • I will check off each student who has the supplies needed to begin working. 	<p>Friday, September 9th</p>
<p>Practice Day</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use this day to practice with your new materials, look up reference images, practice drawing certain images in your sketchbook, test designs, etc. 	<p>Friday, September 16th</p>
<p>In-class Progress Checks</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You will need to have all of your materials and project out and working the entire period in order to receive your progress points for the day. 	<p>Fridays, September 23rd and 30th</p>
<p>Mid-semester Project Critique</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Every student will need to give a brief presentation to the class about the progress you have made on your Genius Hour project and what you will do when we return from Fall Break. • You will also need to complete two written critiques of two classmates' work during class. 	<p>Week of October 3rd-7th</p>
